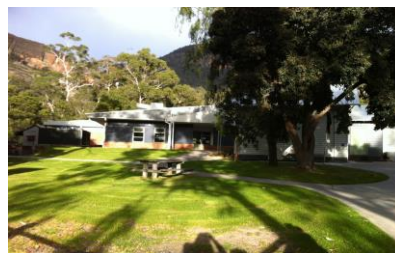

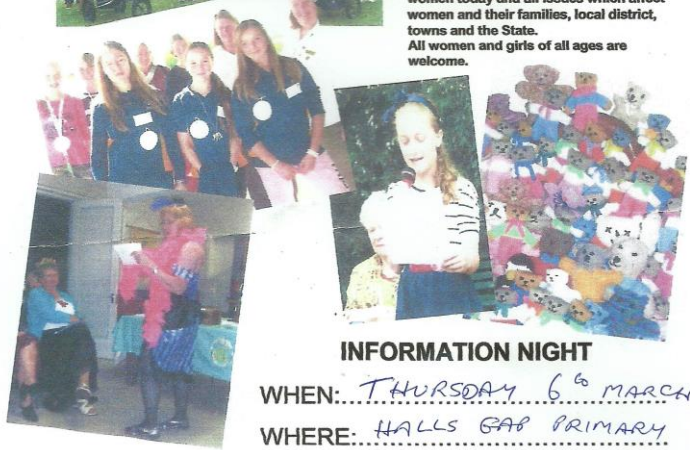


The Country Women's Association is a non-party political and non-sectarian organisation, for country and city women everywhere.
