You have to register with PlayHQ (Approx \$39) before you take the court. Our fees are \$60 per season.

It is a requirement that you are able to **reliably** commit to the club each week for those 2 hours. You have to be able to do this for our competition to **function effectively**.

You are required by Basketball Australia to have a current Working with Children check before you take the court. You can apply for a free volunteer one online.

NO EXPERIENCE is necessary to play, members will help players who are new to the sport. We welcome anyone over the age of 16, regardless of their experience or skill level.

The competition is purely social with an emphasis on participation, fun & inclusion.

We are a child friendly competition. Children are welcome and are provided with toys to play with. They are in full view of the court. Players are rostered on to be with them.

You will be rostered on duty every fortnight or you may volunteer to umpire.

We hold fun days, dinners & special events, on occasion, to give players the chance to enjoy time together off the court.

We don't play during school holidays or on public holidays.

The club provides you with a singlet to wear during the season & this is returned prior to leaving on the last week.
